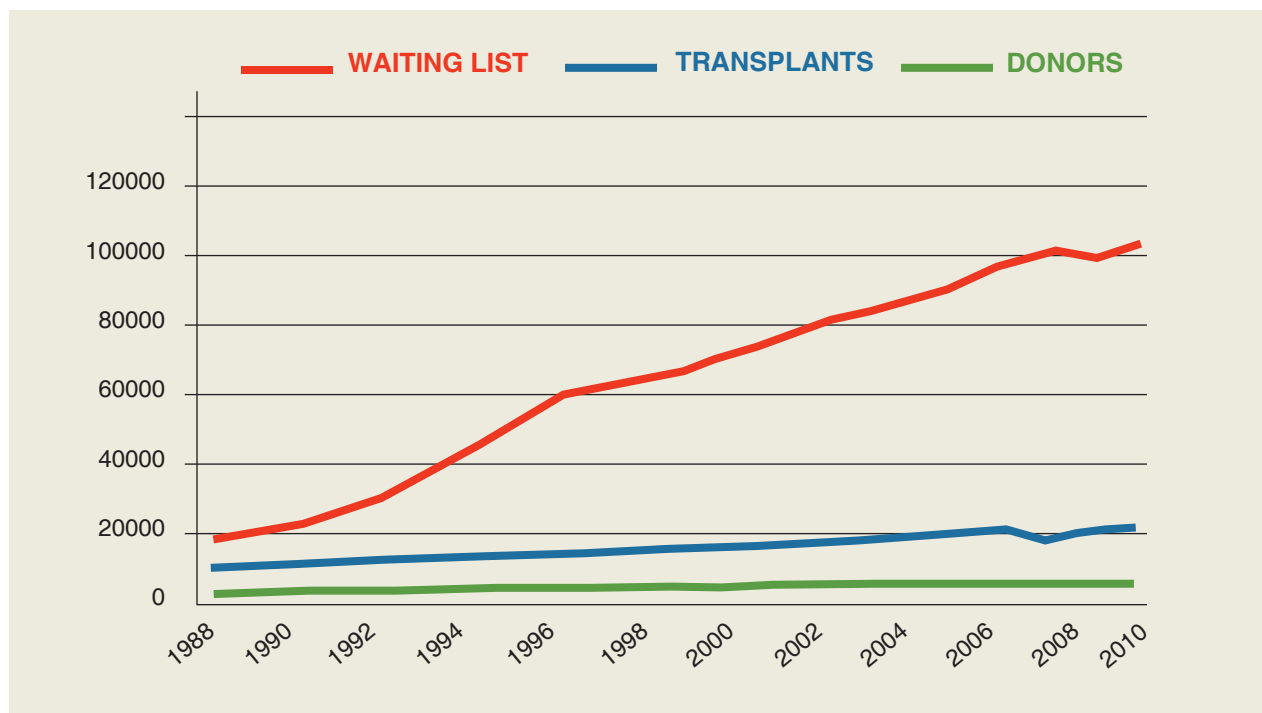


National Organ Donation Statistics for 2009

2,422,000	The number of people who died in the US, between June 2008 and June 2009.*
8,022	The number of deceased organ donors in 2009. Less than 1% of the people who died in 2009 were able to become actual donors.
24,212	The number of organ transplants from deceased donors in 2009.**
105,000+	The number of people who were waiting for a life-saving transplant at year end 2009.**

Because of the small number of donors each year, the gap between the number of people waiting for a life saving transplant and the number of donated organs available continues to grow.
